Topic: Call From Kip Wright

Narrative Reporting Officer: Timmerman, Doug 5423

On Tuesday November the 8th, 2016 I received a call from Kip Wright of the Mercer County Prosecutors Office. Wright stated that he would like to talk to me about this case. Wright and I set up a time for 1230 hrs on that date.

I went to the Prosecutors Office and met with Wright. Wright has some affiliation with Wright State University Lake Campus and does some Student Conduct work for the university. Wright stated that when the article on this case was made public by WCSM Radio, he was approached by [REDACTED] at the Lake Campus. The [REDACTED], who is a [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had also received text messages in the past from Jared Springer. In those messages, Springer was asking [REDACTED] for "sexy" pictures.

Wright stated that he was also told that another member of WSULC ([REDACTED]) that there was an [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) who is an [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] got a similar request for Springer on sending photo's. It was my understanding that these people may or may not be willing to come forward to file a report. Wright stated that at this time he felt that it was just them wanting him to know about the incidents.

Wright then stated that he was approached on the street near Celina Municipal Court one day by attorney [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised Wright that [REDACTED] had a client ([REDACTED]) [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] client ([REDACTED]) has a juvenile [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] has been approached by Springer in the past and he sent [REDACTED] a request via texting that he wanted a "sexy selfie" of [REDACTED].

It is my understanding that [REDACTED] is a [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] and that Springer bothered [REDACTED] there. [REDACTED] must have approached the owner of [REDACTED] and asked [REDACTED] to have Springer stop his conduct with [REDACTED], which [REDACTED] did via a message sent to Springer.

Today (November the 10th, 2016) I called [REDACTED] and spoke with [REDACTED] at length. [REDACTED] was asked to explain this situation to me. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both work at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that Springer and his wife (Deanna) both used to come in quit often as customers and would sit at the bar and that [REDACTED] would be their waitress. [REDACTED] stated that they seemed like very nice people and [REDACTED] enjoyed them coming in due to the fact that they tipped [REDACTED] well. [REDACTED] stated that one night, Springer asked [REDACTED] for [REDACTED] phone number in the event that they ever needed a [REDACTED] some day. [REDACTED] provided Springer with [REDACTED] number and he quickly asked [REDACTED] for a picture to add to his phone as a contact. [REDACTED] spoke with other members of the [REDACTED] staff and asked if [REDACTED] should do that and they stated that would be fine. [REDACTED] sent Springer a picture of [REDACTED] "Senior Pictures". After that picture was sent, Springer stated that it was a sexy picture and asked for something a little more sexier. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] also got a message one morning at 5 am and he had sent a picture stating "it hump day", being a wednesday.

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] sent Deanna the messages and Deanna sent a reply back stating that she was upset and trying to rap her head and heart around this matter. [REDACTED] stated that this occured sometime in July or August of this year.

The thing I find interesting is that Deanna said the exact something via text to [REDACTED] and to [REDACTED]. I also see that Springer had sent the same "hump day" picture to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] would like to see charges filed on [REDACTED] case and wants Springer to serve at least one day in jail. I explained to [REDACTED] about Hatcher being the special prosecutor on this case and explained that it may be possible for him to plea this case and [REDACTED] case. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] did not care how it was handled, as long as he got something from court. I told [REDACTED] that I would touch base with Hatcher and get his thoughts on this matter.

I also have pictures from Kip Wright (e-mail) that was sent to him from [REDACTED] of some of the messages.

On September the 1st, 2016 I was contacted at my residence by [REDACTED] around 2134 hrs. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] wanted to talk to me about a problem with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] for a five (5) year old boy, who was the son of Jared Springer.

[REDACTED] stated that it was brought to [REDACTED] attention that [REDACTED] reported to [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had been getting text messages from Springer and that they were making [REDACTED] uncomfortable. [REDACTED] stated that the messages were natured in the form that Springer wanted selfie's of [REDACTED] (pictures taken by oneself on a phone and sent to the other party).

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] began to ask for "Sexy selfie's" and "cute selfie's". [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] to the Coldwater Police Department and spoke with Patrolman Calvin Freeman. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] likes Freeman, but they are not satisfied with what action he and or the Coldwater Police Department was doing about this matter. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] knew me from the past and wanted to know what we could do to assist [REDACTED] on this matter.

[REDACTED] also advised that [REDACTED] did call and speak with Springer's wife and told her what was going on and that [REDACTED] would not be [REDACTED] for them any longer. [REDACTED] stated that Springer's wife was very upset as she had no knowledge of this behavior. [REDACTED] stated that he told Springer's wife to make sure that her husband no longer text [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] did get another text from Springer that night, however [REDACTED] is unsure that [REDACTED] had a chance to tell him about that warning yet.

I advised [REDACTED] that it was not our office policy to take calls from other agencies, however I would have to check with a supervisor on that. I also advised [REDACTED] that I would like some time to review any possible charge that may fit this crime. [REDACTED] and I agreed that we would meet at my office the next morning at 0630 hrs.

The next morning, [REDACTED] did not arrive at 0630 hrs; however [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] did show up at that time. I brought them back to my office and asked them if they would be willing to write a statement of the events that took place. They both agreed to do that, however they wished to take the statement forms home and complete them there. I provided them with some forms and also advised that if they wished they could type them, but to make sure that they signed them.

Detective Fortkamp then took several photo's of the text messages that [REDACTED] had on [REDACTED] phone (with their permission). Fortkamp stated that he would down load those to this report.

[REDACTED] also advised us in person that Springer had also rubbed [REDACTED] thigh a couple of times in the car, when he would pick [REDACTED] up to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] also stated that [REDACTED] was outside of Springer's house one day in [REDACTED] bathing suit playing water games with the five year old, when Springer came out and put his arms around [REDACTED] shoulder. [REDACTED] stated that this did make [REDACTED] uncomfortable.

I reviewed the Telecommunications Harassment law and felt that section six (6) fit this incident. I called and spoke with Assistant Mercer County Prosecutor Andy Hinders and advised him of this and he stated that it did fit, but that he thought we should attempt to interview the suspect first, which I advised that we wanted to do, but wanted a preliminary review quick (reason for the call).

I also covered this case with Chief Deputy Thobe and Sheriff Grey. They advised to make sure that the [REDACTED] in fact want our office to do the investigation, which was very obvious by [REDACTED] conversation earlier this morning and to do some interviews before we send the case to Hinders for review of charges.

I did call [REDACTED] cell phone at 1422 hrs this date and asked if they in fact still want us to investigate this case to add the request to their statement form.

At this time this case is still under investigation.
