
Now comes the State of Ohio, by and through the Prosecuting Attorney Matthew K. Fox and herewith requests this Court continue the Trial in this matter currently scheduled for February 26, 27 and 28, 2019.

At the Final Pretrial which commenced on February 13, 2019 and during an informal Pretrial Conference held by agreement on February 19, 2019, it became clear that there are several significant pretrial issues which, in the interest of judicial economy, should be resolved before the trial commences, and that there is insufficient time to fully litigate those issues before February 26, 2019. These issues included arguments regarding certain jury instruction, which party bears the burden of proof regarding "privilege," whether Defendant is permitted to videotape the trial, and the exclusion of certain evidence/exhibits.

Wherefore, the State of Ohio requests this matter be continued.
